SAW is a membership organisation initiating and managing a range of events, projects and opportunities throughout the county, the well known Somerset Art Weeks event now runs annually. Projects in hand include new skills workshops, a new members' website with links to other sites, special rates for workshops and seminars, a public liability insurance scheme, a Friends' of SAW mailing list and monthly e-bulletins with details of projects, other opportunities and information.

Members are asked to renew their membership annually to ensure they continue to receive up to date information about developments and opportunities. In the absence of payment of the renewal fee your membership will lapse and your information will be automatically removed from our Website by our database system. It is compulsory that participants of the Art Weeks events maintain continuous membership.

Membership is due for renewal in NOVEMBER each year. Would you please complete an up-to-date application form with your renewal as it assists us in checking that the details we have on our database are correct. Members can update their contact details by logging into the website via their log-in and password.
